
#### STUDENT'S ID



# Orientation in the buildings

Teaching process is realized in Petržalka, Dolnozemská cesta 1, 852 35 Bratislava in 2 buildings, which are separate but linked together.

The buildings are labelled as **V1 the old building** (on the left side) and **V2 the new building** (on the right side).

**Building V1** – Library of EU (2.-4. Floor)

**Building V2** is the house of rectorate EU in Bratislava, all the offices, centre of PE and also of our faculty. The teaching process is although held in both of the buildings.

**Assembly hall** is located in front of the old building, where all the ceremonies take place.

#### LABELLING OF CLASSROOMS

**V1**: the rooms in the buildings in the entrance-hall and on the counter levels are labelled by the letter of the block and the number of the room (for example: D 115). The rooms up from the first floor are labelled by the number of the floor, letter of the block and the number of the room (for example: 1D15). The rooms C you will find on the ground floor, on the right side behind the buffet.

**V2**: the rooms are labelled by the letter of the block, number of the floor, a dot and the number of the room (for example: D1.15)

#### SLOVAK LIBRARY OF ECONOMY

Located in the building V1 on the 2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> floor

In the library you firstly need to register for a low fee and based on your ISIC card you will be able to borrow study materials. The area of the library is adjusted for studying. <a href="http://www.sek.euba.en/">http://www.sek.euba.en/</a>

**Copying, press and sell of office supplies** is located in the new building V1 on the counter level behind chill-out zone in room D201 or in the building V2 in room D1.06 (behind the lifts)

**Self- service copying** you can find in the building V1 in the area of SEK (2<sup>nd</sup> floor) and on the counter level by TULI centre.

**Self-service machines ROBOCOP** are located in the buildings V1 and V2 in the entrance-hall

They are operating from 1 of October until 15 of May 6:30h-20:00h.




